European Tournament: 8-9th June

This two day competition attracts over 600 competitors from over 62 schools within the UK and Europe.

The Grandmaster and many Senior Masters from the USA travel to oversee the event. On Friday the 8th June, DBNs and Black-belts of all ranks undertake National Testings' in the morning (09.30-13.00) and do demo practice in the afternoon (13.30-15.00). That evening there are the 2nd, 3rd and 4th degree tournaments (17.30-19.00).

On Saturday the 9th June the1st degree competition take place at 08.00 followed by the under Black-belt competitions from 08.15. The day culminates with Black-belt promotions ceremony and a superb Masters Exhibition in the evening at 19.00. This year PSBN Karen undertakes

her first test for 4th degree, JKN Nathan his first test for 2nd degree and DBN's Barry and Jemma promote to 1st degree black-belt.

Competitors, please return your forms to PSBN Karen with your cheques or cash asap. (Adult spectators cost £8 and Children £5, on the day).
